## FROM THE DESK OF THE PRESIDENT

Well summer is almost over. Cooler weather is coming so it will soon be comfortable to visit the range and do some shooting. We will be looking forward to seeing you at the range.

There will be a Hunters Site in Days at the range on Saturday, September 12<sup>th</sup> from 8:00 A.M. till Noon and Sunday, September 13<sup>th</sup> from Noon till 4:00 P.M. We will have knowledgeable shooters to on hand to help you, if necessary. There will be no charge, courtesy of the Boulder Rifle and Pistol Club members. Tell your hunting buddies to come on out and sight in their rifles.

The club is looking for a good used 4X4 pick up with a utility bed, extended or regular cab, air conditioner, ¾ ton preferred, for a range truck. If you know of one that is for sale, please call 293-1885 and leave a message. I will get back to you.

We will be doing some work on the silhouette range and pit #8 on the courtesy range. Pit #8 will be extended to 100 yards and bench rests will be installed. On the silhouette range we will be raising the target backstops and making them longer so we can add targets. We will also build a berm for the long-range target on the silhouette range and install a large and a small target at the 800-yard berm.

The vintage military rifle match, shoot on the 1<sup>st</sup> Sunday, will start up again on Nov 1<sup>st</sup>. The shooters will be elsewhere in October. For more information call the club office.

The 3-gun September night match has been changed to a day shoot. The regular shooters think three night shoots are enough.

The board of Directors have decided that next year the club office will be closed after the **1<sup>st</sup> Sat in July until Sept. 1<sup>st</sup> 2010.**

We do not prorate the dues. You will be required to send your dues to the P.O. Box. The Range Safety Officers will not accept payments at the range. We will be sending out a newsletter in November to remind members when the 2010 dues are due.

The F-Class name has been changed to the new NRA Designation Mid Range match. This incorporates F-Class (prone with rests) and prone without rests. They will start again on the 3<sup>rd</sup> Sunday in Sept.

The range orientation on November 7th will be changed from 9:00 A.M. to 2:00 P.M. due to a Hi Power Match. New members will be notified before the orientation.

We hope you all enjoy the new pavement going into the range. There have been many questions on paving the road from the dump. That is a city road and has different rules for paving.

**NEWS AND NOTES FROM THE VARIOUS DISCIPLINES**

**HIGH POWER** - Practice for the 24th of October has been moved to October the 17th, same time and place, to accommodate the upcoming USPSA Match.

The USPSA Match is scheduled for the 21st through the 25th of October, and very likely will be as large as the Eldorado Cowboy Championship. This Match will most likely use up a significant portion of our range.

1) Palma shooting is done from the prone position at distances of 800, 900, and 1000 yards. Both scoped and iron sighted rifles can be used. This discipline shoots on the 2nd Sunday morning of each month. Please arrive at 07:00, if you would like to participate. New and experienced long range shooters are welcome.

2) High Power "across the course" shooting is executed from the standing, sitting, and prone position at 200, 300, and 600 yards. Iron sighted rifles only are used in this discipline which shoots on the 4th Sunday morning of each month starting at 07:00. New and experienced High Power shooters are welcome.

3) The club will host the 3rd annual Southern Nevada Palma Championship on November 6, 7, and 8th. Match bulletin and entry forms are available on the club's website. The club section of the range will be closed from approximately 07:00 to 1:30 pm on these days. The courtesy range will be open during these times.

**JUNIORS -**

The Boulder Rifle and Pistol Club will be starting the Juniors Program on Saturday, November 7 at 10:30. This program is available to all youth from twelve to eighteen years old. Club membership is not required. The club will furnish

## **ELDORADO COWBOYS -**

The Eldorado Cowboys will be hosting our Tenth Annual SASS Nevada State Championship at Boulder Rifle and Pistol Club October 1 thru October 4, 2009.

If you have never seen Single Action Shooting, you might want to take some time and come out and see it first hand. The best times would be Friday and/or Saturday morning from 9:00 until about noon. We currently have 137 shooters signed up for the championship.

In order to put on this event, we will start setting up the facades and steel starting on Monday morning, September 28, 2009. The courtesy bays will be closed from September 28, 2009 through October 5, 2009 during set up and the event. We will start tearing down everything on Sunday morning, October 5, 2009.

The member's area will be open during this time.

We will go back to our regular winter shooting schedule for the remainder of the year with our November weekend. We will be using three bays in the member's area and a fourth bay will be closed during our shooting as a safety measure.

We will have our side match events starting at 8:00 a.m. with our main match shooting at 9:00 a.m. We usually finish shooting around noon. Following is the shooting schedule for the remainder of the year and the first weekend in 2010.
