BOB RAIDER - By-Law changes - The Board of Directors has identified some updates changes to our By-Laws to better define the types of memberships available in our club and reflect the way we currently operate. In addition to regular and junior members we have included "limited" memberships which apply to users of the courtesy range. We have also included the requirement of regular members to attend the new member orientation briefing. There are no changes to the privileges or fees for the regular members.

A number of members have been having problems opening the gate locks and try to force them open by yanking them very hard towards open. This has caused some of the locks to break. There is a spring loaded internal pin that must be released before the lock will open. Squeezing the lock towards closed releases the pressure on the pin so it can move out of engagement mode and allow the lock to open. Thank you for your assistance in helping increase the life of the locks.

JOE – BRENNAN - Vintage Military Rifle Silhouette – You may shoot any WWII or older military rifle from any country both bolt or semi. Our shoot is held the 1st Sunday of each month. We shoot steel silhouettes and plates from 200 to 960 yards from the bench, prone, sitting and standing positions. Surplus ammo is welcome. Set up is at 8 am with shooting at 9 am.
